CSDDevNet Announces Appointment of Mr. Monday Abuh as National Network Coordinator

Abuja, Nigeria — Climate and Sustainable Development Network (CSDDevNet) is pleased to announce the appointment of Mr. Monday Abuh as its National Network Coordinator (NNC), effective March 25, 2023. The appointment was formally confirmed by the CSDDevNet Board of Directors, in recognition of Mr. Abuh's demonstrated leadership, commitment to advancing climate action and sustainable development, and his longstanding service to the Network.

As National Network Coordinator, Mr. Abuh serves as the chief executive officer of the Network, responsible for the overall coordination and management of CSDDevNet's programmes, operations, partnerships, and strategic engagements. He is authorized to represent the Network before government institutions, development partners, international organizations, funding agencies, and other stakeholders, subject to the governance oversight of the Board of Directors.

In this role, Mr. Abuh's responsibilities include:

- Providing strategic leadership for the implementation of CSDDevNet's vision, mission, and programmes.
- Managing the day-to-day operations and administration of the Network.
- Coordinating national and international partnerships and representing CSDDevNet at relevant meetings and events.
- Mobilizing resources and ensuring the effective implementation of projects and programmes.
- Supervising staff, consultants, and volunteers in accordance with the policies of the Network.
- Reporting periodically to the Board of Directors on the activities, finances, and performance of the organization.
- Performing such other duties as may be assigned by the Board of Directors from time to time.

Speaking on the appointment, **Prof. Ibrahim Dinju Choji, mni**, Chairman of the CSDDevNet Board of Trustees, expressed the Board's confidence in Mr. Abuh's ability to continue providing effective leadership, and extended the Board's congratulations on his appointment.

Responding to his appointment, **Mr. Monday Abuh** said: *“I am deeply honoured to take on this role and grateful to the Board for their continued trust. CSDevNet has always been about bringing communities, government, and partners together to build real climate resilience, and I am committed to strengthening that work, deepening our partnerships, expanding our advocacy, and ensuring the Network remains a strong, credible voice for climate justice and sustainable development in Nigeria and across the continent.”*

CSDevNet's leadership and membership join in congratulating Mr. Abuh on his appointment and look forward to his continued leadership in advancing the Network's climate and sustainable development agenda across Nigeria and beyond.

About Mr. Monday Abuh

Monday Abuh is a climate justice strategist and environmental sustainability advocate with over five years of experience in project coordination, stakeholder engagement, and policy advocacy. He holds an academic background in Microbiology, Environmental Biology, and Fisheries & Aquaculture, which he combines with hands-on experience in programme management, data collection, and grassroots mobilisation.

Prior to his appointment as National Network Coordinator, Mr. Abuh served as Programme Manager at CSDevNet, Field Assistant at Solidaridad Network West Africa, and North Central Coordinator at the Communicating Development Initiative (CDI). He is also Chairman of the Board of Trustees at the Ecosystem Sustainability Network (EcoSusNet), and serves as a Pan-African Climate Justice Alliance (PACJA) Coordinator for Young Digital Activists, where he leverages digital platforms to amplify climate action and policy advocacy across Africa.

His contributions to global climate discussions include participation in multiple United Nations Climate Change Conferences (COPs), Africa Climate Week, and high-level environmental strategy meetings. His work bridges grassroots action with national and global climate policy, making him a key voice in Nigeria's environmental landscape.
